Computer Science & AI

Programmes: Computer Science and Engineering; Artificial Intelligence; Data Science; Cyber Security; Information Technology; BCA; MCA.

Eligibility:

Students from computer science, IT, software, mathematics, or related fields. Basic programming background preferred.

Engineering & Technology

Programmes: Aerospace Engineering; Civil Engineering; Chemical Engineering; Mechanical Engineering; Electrical Engineering; Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering; VLSI Design and Technology; Biotechnology Engineering.

Eligibility:

Students enrolled in engineering or technology disciplines, or related science-based programmes with mathematics and technical foundation.

Biotechnology & Applied Sciences

Programmes: B.Tech Biotechnology; Integrated M.Tech Biotechnology; Applied Microbiology; Statistics and Data Analytics; Mathematics; Physics; Chemistry; Environmental Science.

Eligibility:

Students from biotechnology, microbiology, life sciences, chemistry, mathematics, physics, environmental science, or related disciplines.

Management & Commerce

Programmes: BBA; B.Com; M.Com; Business Analytics; Finance; Marketing; Human Resource Management; International Business; MBA in Agribusiness Management; MBA in Rural Management.

Eligibility:

Students from business, commerce, economics, management, entrepreneurship, or related fields.

Law, Governance & Public Policy

Programmes: B.A. LL.B. (Hons.); B.B.A. LL.B. (Hons.); B.Sc. LL.B. (Hons.); International Law; Business Law; Constitutional Law; Criminal Law; Human Rights; Master in Public Policy.

Eligibility:

Students from law, public policy, governance, political science, international relations, or related disciplines.

Humanities & Social Sciences

Programmes: Economics; English; Sociology; Psychology; Development Studies; Gender Studies; Indian Society and Culture; Peace and Conflict Studies; Sustainable Development.

Eligibility:

Students from humanities, liberal arts, social sciences, development studies, or related fields.

Languages & Intercultural Studies

Programmes: French; German; Japanese; Spanish; English Communication; Indian Languages and Culture; Cross-Cultural Communication; Indian Civilization and Heritage.

Eligibility:

Students of languages, literature, communication, cultural studies, or any students with strong interest in language and intercultural learning.

Journalism, Media & Communication

Programmes: Bachelor of Communication and Journalism; Master of Communication and Journalism; Journalism; Digital Media; Public Relations; Advertising; Corporate Communication; Film and Television Production.

Eligibility:

Students from journalism, media, communication, public relations, advertising, film, or related disciplines.

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Design, Fashion & Creative Studies

Programmes: Graphic Design; Product Design; UX Design; Fashion Design; Textile Design; Visual Communication; Design Thinking and Innovation.

Eligibility:

Students from design, fine arts, architecture, media, or other creative disciplines. Portfolio preferred where applicable.

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Hospitality, Tourism & Sports

Programmes: Hospitality and Tourism; Tourism Management; Event Management; Sports Management; Physical Education and Sports; Yoga and Wellness; Sports Science; International Sports and Cultural Exchange.

Eligibility:

Students from hospitality, tourism, sports, wellness, physical education, event management, or related fields.



General Eligibility

- Must be enrolled in a recognized foreign university.
- Nomination or recommendation from the home university is preferred.
- Learning agreement / academic mapping required before arrival.
- Typical study load: 16–24 credits per semester.
- English proficiency required.
- Official transcript may be issued after successful completion.
- Credit transfer subject to home university approval.
- Admission subject to seat availability and semester offerings.
